Please keep in mind that, as student representatives of Bishop Grimes Jr./Sr. High School, you and your dates are called to a moral standard that is higher than in other segments of our society. To that end, I remind you that modesty must be observed when Grimes students, or their dates, are choosing prom clothes. Bare mid-riffs, cut-outs, décolleté (low cut necklines) and/or backless and/or strapless dresses are not acceptable attire for this event. Dresses must be of a modest length, at least to the mid-thigh. Suits or formal attire is required for gentlemen. During the course of the evening jackets and vests may be removed, but not shirts.

All junior and senior girls will attend the Prom Fashion Show that will be held in the Sheehan gym on Friday, February 26th from 2:15 until 2:45 pm. Boys who are bringing girls to the prom who are not from BG need to be sure their dates follow the guidelines listed above. Remember, too, that alcohol, tobacco or any other drug use is also not acceptable at **any** Bishop Grimes School activity.
