Fall Driver Education

The Fall Driver Education course being offered at Bishop Grimes consists of classroom instruction and in-car instruction. Students have 1.5 hours of in-car instruction and 1.5 hours of classroom instruction each week, from September 23, 2024 - January 12, 2025. The course is approved by the New York State Education Department. Successful completion will entitle the student to receive an MV 285 Certificate (formerly known as a “blue card”) and an insurance reduction certificate.
